MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

The 2020 band week schedule is much less intense than a typical season due to the coronavirus restrictions. Our top priority will ALWAYS be your health & safety. If at any point during the week you begin to feel ill, please do not participate in any band activities. Follow the university's guidelines if you suspect you may have contracted COVID-19. You will NOT be penalized for missing a rehearsal due to illness or suspected illness.

We will closely monitor all activities throughout the week and make any accommodations necessary to ensure the health and safety of our CMB members. It is possible that some events may be modified, reduced, or cancelled if we need to adapt them.

Once classes begin on August 17, we rehearse M / W / F from 4:00 – 6:00 pm. Most rehearsals will be staggered such that you will only play for one hour or less per day, and there may be days that you don't play at all. We will have a detailed rehearsal schedule that we release by the end of band week outlining exactly what days / times you will rehearse once classes begin. All rehearsals will take place *within* the M/W/F 4-6 pm scheduled rehearsal time.
